### **Justice Africa Sudan Condemns the Deadly Attack on IDP Camp in Kadugli South Kordofan State On Friday, 31, October 2025**

Justice Africa Sudan strongly condemns the recent drone strike on an Internally Displaced Persons (IDP) camp in Kadugli, South Kordofan state, which resulted in the tragic loss of five siblings and injured six others.

On October 31, 2025, at approximately 11:00 a.m. a drone strike attributed to the Tassis Alliance, consisting of the Rapid Support Forces (RSF) and the Sudan People's Liberation Army-North (SPLA-N), targeted the IDP camp run by the International Organization for Migration (IOM) in Kadugli. The attack claimed the lives of five innocent children from the same family:

## Justice Africa Sudan:

- Strongly condemns this heinous attack on civilians, including women, children, and the elderly, which is a flagrant violation of international humanitarian law and human rights.

Urges the parties to the conflict in Sudan to:

- Immediately cease all attacks on civilian populations and IDP camps.
- Ensure the protection and safety of civilians and humanitarian workers.
- Hold those responsible for these atrocities accountable for their actions.
- Provide urgent humanitarian assistance to those affected by the attacks.

We stand in solidarity with the victims and their families and urge everyone to work towards a peaceful resolution to the conflict.
